CHOOSE EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY



European University is a fully student-oriented educational institution which provides grants for its students.

It is focused on supporting intercultural dialogue. For this purpose, it establishes such an environment where each student feels as the plenipotentiary member of society despite ethnic, racial, religious or other distinguishing features.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

School leavers possessing the right to study without taking national exams should attach the following documents to the application addressed to the university rector:

I.Notarized copy of the document verifying citizenship;

2.Notarized copy of the document verifying obtaining higher secondary education in the foreign country or its equivalent;

3. The document recognizing the education received issued by the LEPL National Centre of Education Quality Development


5. Photo 3X4.

6. In case of the trusted person/guardian, notarized letter of authorization.

Those who express the desire to learn should ensure recognition of the educational documents issued in the foreign country before submitting their documentation to the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia at the National Centre for Quality Development.

After the approval of the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia they will be granted the right to start studying the European University.

Medical Program

- Qualification Awarded: Medical Doctor (MD)
- Language of Instruction: English
- Program Capacity: 360 credits

PROGRAM GOAL

The objective of the program is to prepare a specialist in the field of healthcare for vocational activities of practical nature. The program also aims to provide the graduates with not only the theoretical knowledge, but development of clinical skills and ethical values essential for this career. By maintaining a high level of teaching and learning, the program intends to prepare specialists who will know how to improve health conditions of patients and society based on integration of their theoretical and practical knowledge.

DENTISTRY

- Qualification Awarded: Doctor of Dental Medicine
- Language of instruction: Georgian/English
- Program Capacity: 300 credits

PROGRAM GOALS

In line with modern demands of the job market, the program aims to shape a qualified specialist of theoretical and practical skills who will be able to successfully go through the vocational development program and become competitive in the job market. The objective of the program is to ensure that a student develops practical skills in various fields of dentistry. The program covers the blocks of subjects related to the dentistry, including: Pediatric Dentistry, Surgical Dentistry, Orthopedic Dentistry, and Orthodontics. Dental education courses includes working, a role playing, and other activities in the phantom laboratory that provides direct contact of a student to dental research objects, instruments and materials at clinics and working out practical skills in different fields of dentistry.



SELECTING STUDENTS

Before enrolling students into the foreign language program, the exam and oral interview are conducted with them in the English language. The applicant should meet the requirements of B2 level and have good command of spoken and written English.



APPLYING FOR A VISA

As an international student you can study and live in Georgia if you are a proper visa holder. Foreigners coming to Georgia for the long-term study purpose are issued the immigration visa (D 3 category) with the term of 90 calendar days and multi-entry right. Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Georgia, diplomatic representation of Georgia abroad and the consular department make the decision about issuing the D category visa within the period of 30 calendar days after submitting the visa application.

- 3. Receipt verifying the payment of the consular fee;

- 5. Documents verifying the purpose of travel in Georgia;

- 8. Document verifying the existence of sufficient funds during the desirable travel period;
- 9. Document verifying the existence of the place of residence;
- 10. Travel and health insurance;

II. Document verifying the payment of the fine in case the foreigner was imposed the fine for staying in Georgia illegally;

12. In case the document is submitted to the visa issuing body via the representatives, it is necessary to have the document verifying the right of representation.

With its outstanding and incredibly impressive nature, there are definitely countless wonders in Georgia that should not be missed if you have even a bit chance to travel around.



The cultural and art life of Georgia is centered in Tbilisi where you can get endless opportunities to become familiar with the rich historic and cultural heritage of our country.



DanceSport is equally popular in Tbilisi where you can find plenty of Dance Studios giving a chance to take group classes or private dance lessons.





Tbilisi is also well-known for its uncountable bakeries in every corner of almost each street.

Those who seek relax and entertainment Tbilisi offers a wide range of places to choose from. Peaceful and comfortable atmosphere at Spa and Wellness Centers and Hotels in Tbilisi is really good choice to get away from the noise of the city and feel absolutely chilled out while Aqua Parks with Jacuzzi, massage therapy and artificial rivers are for those willing to escape from summer heat and have unforgettable fun with friends.



Tbilisi is also one of the liveliest cities with many cinemas, theatres and its popular nightlife. Located in the heart of the city, Shardeni Street with its pavement cafes, bars and night clubs is one of the most bohemian and exciting areas in old Tbilisi. Those who prefer to spend their evening on a place with views, terrace bars with outdoor seating are great to dine and admire stunning views of Night Tbilisi. When it comes to packing, don't bring unnecessary items since it's allowed to take only the limited amount of luggage - 2 or 3 suitcases. You should check the permitted amount of weight of each suitcase on the web site of a particular airline. Remember also that you can get most things quite cheaply and immediately in Tbilisi.

Pack Wisely

In your bag, money-belt or secure pocket you should keep your passport, visa, travel tickets, travel insurance documents, credit card. Make sure you have Georgian currency in cash for your first few days; try to include 5 and 10 GEL notes.

IN YOUR HAND LUGGAGE

• A photocopy of each page of your passport with clear picture of your passport number, date and place of issue and visas/entry.

• Original academic documents with you to Georgia as you will need to present them during the process of registration (All the documents provided by the university such as invitation letter, copy of the order certifying your enrollment in the University).

- List of contents of main luggage
- Any prescribed medication including a letter from your doctor.
- Details of your accommodation with address and phone number.
- Original documentary proof of having enough money to meet your living costs (eg. bank statements, proof of scholarship, letter of a sponsor)

Photocopies of all essential documents.

IN YOUR SUITCASE

- Enough closes that last you until you settle.
- Essential textbooks only.
- list of the items in your hand luggage.

• Keep a copy of address of your final destination with a phone number in a prominent place so that the airline can easily reach you if your luggage gets lost.



Pack Wisely

If you want to send some of your luggage separately by air or with a shipping company before you arrive, make sure there is someone in Tbilisi to accept it. The University might not be able to do this.

LOST PROPERTY

There is hardly any student to have problems with his/her travel but if your luggage gets lost, immediately contact the airline. If you left anything at the airport, bus or train station, go to the Lost Property Office right away to find out whether your luggage have been found and handed in. Otherwise you can address the police for help.

SECURITY WHILE TRAVELLING

- Be watchful and try to be sleepless while you are travelling.
- Always make sure you don't leave your belongings unattended even for a short period of time.
- Do not walk around with expensive gadgets and valuables visible.
- Do not bring more cash than necessary for the travelling costs and a few days in Tbilisi until you access it from your credit card.
- Keep a record of important documents like credit card, medical insurance if your wallet or any important documents get stolen, it's important to know what is missing.
- If your passport is lost, you should address the police at once.



All the students who want to have an access on the Georgian border, have to pass boarding control.

o Be confident o Be calm

Make sure, that you have all the necessary documents prepared: As soon as the students arrive on the border of Georgia, University representatives will meet them on the airport. There are several ways to get from the airport to the center of Tbilisi.

Train

The Airport railway station is the cheapest and the easiest means of transportation as it connects Tbilisi central railway station with the airport. It is located 70 meters from the airport building. With the new train station passengers can now get to the airport in 20 minutes. One-way fare is 0,50 GEL.

Bus

Public bus stop is located in front of the Arrival hall and provides passenger transportation on route # 37 - Airport-Tbilisi city center - Airport. Working hours – 24/7 One-way fee is 0.50 GEL

Taxi

Taxi service at Tbilisi International Airport is available outside the terminal, just at the curbside of the Arrival Hall and provides 24 hour service to the passengers. The journey time to the city center takes 20-30 minutes dependent on traffic. Taxi fee depends on taxi meter indication (From 30 to 50 GEL).



feel Safe

Tbilisi is the city where you should never be worried about your safety. The crime rate in Georgia is quite low and it is the very reason holds seventh place in the list of the safest countries in the world. The establishment of professional laws reduces the overall crime rates in different cities of Georgia. The best thing is that it increases one's standard of living.

Based on the recent investigations, 98% of foreigners, who took part in the survey, said that they feel absolutely safe being in Georgia territory. To ensure that there is proper safety, Georgian police patrols each street in the towns and cities every day.

The students of European University mention Tbilisi as one of the most cost-effective cities in which to study, which is good news for all our students.

In addition to paying your tuition fees you must also have enough money to cover your living costs. It is important to budget your money carefully.

There are a few examples below that demonstrate current living costs. approximate living costs of a number of our undergraduate international students give you an idea of the typical amounts of money students spend whilst living and studying in Tbilisi.

Robin, a first year Medicine student, lives alone in a private accommodation in Tbilisi, located within the walking distance of the University so he doesn't have any travel costs apart from the cases when he wants to visit the city center and his monthly costs are approximately 377 USD (house rent- 250\$, food-120\$, transport -7\$, personal expanses- 80\$).

Meghana, a third year Medicine student, shares a flat with another student and her monthly living costs are approximately 295 USD a month (House rent -150\$, food -80\$, Transport 15 \$, personal expenses -50\$).
